The groundbreaking Pinhole Surgery Technique for the treatment of gum recession originated with the renowned Dr. John Chao, who discovered a new method for patients experiencing recession to be successfully treated without traditional cutting or suturing. Rather, the repair is completed through small "pinholes" in the gum, allowing for the insertion of specially-designed instruments which gently correct the gum position with "minimal invasiveness," less discomfort and significantly-reduced healing time.

*"Only a handful of Periodontists worldwide have earned the designation of Advanced Pinhole Clinician, and I am absolutely thrilled to be part of this exclusive 'team,'"* says Dr. Faust. *"Now, with the minimally-invasive Pinhole Surgical Technique, patients' recession can be corrected on a potentially limitless number of teeth in one session – significantly reducing healing time and post-operative discomfort."*

*"And if there's one thing we're all about at Bucks County Smiles, it's making our valued patients as comfortable and pain-free as possible."*

According to specialists like Dr. Faust, the procedures previously used to treat recession required dual wounds – one to surgically remove gum tissue from the palate, and another to place the graft over the area of recession. The traditional approach required more invasive surgery and limited the number of teeth that could be treated in a single session; if multiple areas of recession were present, several surgical procedures were necessary to correct them.

What's more, typical healing periods for this previous method were significantly longer, with only small areas able to be accomplished.

*"The key to the Pinhole Surgical Technique is that we do not rely upon traditional 'cut-and-sew' gum grafting,"* adds Dr. Faust. *"The procedure is performed via tiny pinholes without scalpels, incisions or stitching, and the gum tissue is gently shifted to cover the area of recession with minimal trauma to the adjacent tissue. There are no open wounds, and healing is rendered in an advanced way within 24 hours."*

*"To say that patients are amazed by the results and lack of discomfort is something of an understatement."*

Because he believes that a healthy, beautiful smile is the key to success and enhanced self-esteem, Dr. Faust has committed himself to satisfying his patients with a passion to create such healthy, beautiful smiles.
